SPACE SOLUTIONS FOR BUILDING COMMON AREAS

RECEPTION/LOBBY

- Remove unnecessary furniture that does not allow for proper social distancing and/or provide new furniture that allows dividers/space between visitors.
- Provide plexiglass or non-absorbent dividers at reception desks and between furniture.
- Sanitizing stations at entry and exit points.
- Incorporate flooring markers and use wayfinding solutions to direct visitors in lobby areas as well as inside elevators.

ELEVATORS

- Provide floor signage and note distance of riders.
- Provide signage regarding occupancy load of cabs.

CONFERENCE CENTER/TOWN HALL

- Remove furniture and space remaining furniture to allow for proper social distancing.
- Consider dividing large conference rooms into multiple smaller meeting rooms.
- Look into providing open area or outdoor meeting spaces in lieu of closed rooms.
- Control access to these spaces with a mobile phone app.

DINING/CAFÉ

- Remove furniture that is unnecessary and does not allow for proper social distancing.
- Rearrange the existing furniture or purchase new.
 - i.e. include more (2) top tables in lieu of larger tables.
- Open up the dining room entry points.
 - Remove doors or install automatic doors.
- Controlling the traffic and monitor occupancy and/or time allowed per person.
- Provide outdoor seating areas.
- Offer more prepackaged food and/or cut back the menu.
- Order food via phone apps for pickup and payment. Close/remove self serve areas (salad bars, dispensers, vending).



SPACE SOLUTIONS FOR BUILDING COMMON AREAS



FITNESS CENTER

- Remove equipment that does not allow for proper social distancing.
- Spread out the existing equipment and allow for more circulation.
- Consider purchasing multi-use equipment in lieu of single-use equipment to reduce the amount of machines that are used by each person.
- Controlling traffic and density in a fitness center with occupancy indicators and signage.
- Provide outdoor workout spaces.
- Adjusting the hours of operation to limit and monitor accessibility.
- Encourage users to bring their own workout accessories and water bottles in lieu of utilizing the building's equipment.
- Provide additional sanitizing stations and associated trash cans.
- Provide signage and new set standards for Fitness Center usage. Masks must be worn at all times.
- Verify HVAC/Ventilation has proper air flow to keep air moving.
- Provide automatic touchless fixtures throughout.
- Add Touchless door openers to all doors.

RESTROOMS

- Install automatic touchless doors openers or toe door openers.
- Provide wipes and towels near entry and exit points along with associated trash cans
- Update fixtures to automatic in lieu of manual where possible.
 - Automatic paper towels have been shown to spread less germs than automatic hand dryers.

- Post signage and/or reminders regarding recommended hand washing, sanitizing, and cleaning procedures.
- Limit the occupancy allowed in a restroom with occupancy indicators.
- Consider ways to improve the air quality and ventilation in the restroom.
- Utilize existing single-user restrooms or look into providing more single user options.
- Close off every other stall to minimize occupancy and proximity to others.
 - Provide taller and wider privacy screens at urinals and stalls.

SOLUTIONS FOR BUILDING AIR QUALITY

BUILDING SYSTEMS – HVAC and VENTILATION

- Verify building air quality and considers upgrades.
- Provide more frequent air filter changes.
- Biophilia: Install Living / Green walls to improve air quality.
- Update mechanical systems and new technology for better air quality.

How Bipolar Ionization Works to Clean the Air of Pollutants

Much like sunlight does in the atmosphere, Plasma Air technology produces a natural bio-climate rich in positive and negative oxygen ions. The negative ions contain an extra electron while the positive ions are missing an electron resulting in an unstable condition. In an effort to restabilize, these bipolar ions seek out atoms and molecules in the air to trade electrons with, effectively neutralizing particulate matter, bacteria and virus cells, odorous gases and aerosols, and VOCs.
